

# Meet the Coaches

## 2022 PGA Jr. League

*For the 2022 PGA Jr. season we were extremely fortunate to again have program founder and Michigan Golf Hall of Famer, Lynn Janson, back to head the PGA Jr. League at The Legacy at Hastings. In 2022 we were also grateful to gain the support, experience and knowledge of PGA Professional Jock Hopkins. Coaches Janson and Hopkins provided exceptional instruction to the children and taught them valuable lessons for life and the game of golf.*

*Due to the immense support from our donors we were able to offer private lessons and a Youth on Course Membership ([www.youthoncourse.org](http://www.youthoncourse.org)) to each of the children who participated in the program. The Barry County Jr. Golf Association reached an agreement with Coach Hopkins and Coach Janson to provide individual lessons to all our PGA Jr. Members who wanted them at a reduced rate, paid for entirely by our Foundation. We were able to provide nearly 100 lessons to the children. The value of those lessons were immense and we saw the results on the golf course and in the children's confidence levels.*

*Coach Janson and Coach Hopkins not only reduced their typical rate to make the lessons possible but they also donated considerable time to the PGA Jr. Program as a whole. They were there for each practice and match throughout the season. Thankfully, they have both agreed to return for the Summer of 2023 to continue watching the children and program grow.*

*In addition to our coaches, our 2022 season would not have been possible without the support of our team sponsors, Cedar Creek Machinists Training, Kloosterman's Sports Tap, Tripp, Tagg & Storrs, Attorneys at Law and David and Susie Baum who sponsored the Hotsticks Team. We are very thankful for their financial support and investment in the youth of Barry County and our PGA Jr. League.*

This summer we implemented a number of changes to make the league more enjoyable for participants, and coaches and allow the golf course to be more efficient. Those changes were well received and included consistent practices every Tuesday and matches on Fridays and Sundays with the field divided in half to make the golf carts more available and tee times less confusing. The final regular league standings were as follows:*

 Kloosterman's Sports Tap.....17 points*


*In the first round of playoffs Tripp, Tagg & Storrs defeated Kloosterman's Sports Tap and the Hastings Hotsticks defeated CCMT. That led to the third place match being played between Kloosterman's Sports Tap and CCMT. CCMT was victorious and proudly finished third place in the league. The championship match between Tripp, Tagg & Storrs and Hastings Hotsticks was a closely contested match with Tripp, Tagg & Storrs coming out on top, 7.5 to 5.5. The parties were held at The Legacy's tent area which included a massive blow up slide purchased specifically for the PGA Jr. program and numerous other golf related, child focused, games. While not specifically golf related, things like the slide, popcorn, and snow cones certainly made the children excited to come to the golf course.*





## *The Dennis Walters Show*

The Barry County Jr. Golf Association, with the assistance of Mr. Janson, Mr. Alderson and our donors, was able to bring Mr. Dennis Walters and his trick shot routine to The Legacy at Hastings in June of 2022. It was a hot afternoon but it was a very well attended event. The children and adults were able to hear Mr. Walters' story, what he overcame and watch his show with amazement. For those of you who were not able to attend, Mr. Walters has traveled over 3.5 million miles and has amazed audiences at over 3,000 performances. He has appeared in all 50 states, Mexico, across Canada, and the United Kingdom. At each and every show he has been accompanied by one of his canine rescue pals usually, doing about 90-100 shows per year. The show is a program not only of golf lessons, but also life lessons. Dennis tells his story and encourages others to reach for their dreams, strive for excellence and do something they did not think they could. He uses his own personal experience as an example to challenge each person in the audience to do something in their life they thought was impossible, for with hard work, dedication, perseverance, you can achieve success at anything.

In addition, Mr. Walters was able to play in the very first United States Adaptive Open shortly after his show at The Legacy at Hastings. We are very thankful for the support provided to the foundation to make this event happen.

*Thanks to the hard work of our players and coaches, our PGA Jr. League qualified two All-Star teams to the PGA Jr. League National Championship Tournament. This year the regional tournament was held at Binder Park Golf Course in Battle Creek. As many of you may remember, our 2021 All Star team won the regional championship and ended up finishing as the fourth best PGA Jr. League team in the State of Michigan. Grady Matteson & Daylen Sybesma paced our 2022 All-Stars by shooting a two under round of 34. Unfortunately, it was not enough and, we were not able to repeat last year's success on the course. However, the kids had just as much fun participating and gained valuable experience for future events.*

*The PGA Jr. League is for players thirteen and under. Because of the age limit, five players, Lilli Edger, Grady Matteson, Aiden Riffel, Ryann-Lynn Cole, and Colton Wiest played their last event at the All-Star Match. We believe their futures are bright and hope that when you see them, you join with us in encouraging them to continue playing golf. Players must be at least ten years old to play in All-Star Matches and our PGA Jr. League has several nine-year old players who are working hard to fill those five spots and make next year's event.*

# Fundraising

The 2022 Lynn Janson Pro Am is our largest fundraiser of the year and this year's event was a smashing success. We were very fortunate, due largely to Mr. Janson's efforts and reputation, to draw 25 professionals to The Legacy at Hastings to participate in the fundraiser. The 2022 Champion was Mr. Ben Cook who shot an exceptional round of 66 to leave with the prize money. The professionals who attended the event indicated universal enjoyment of their time at The Legacy and their support of the Barry County Junior Golf Association. # Alumni Spotlight

## *Tyler Hausserman*

We are very proud of all of The Legacy's PGA Jr. League alumni and what they accomplish on and off the golf course. But we are especially proud of Tyler Hausserman, class of 2014. Tyler met our Coach, Lynn Janson, when he was 12 years old, started with private lessons, immediately formed a bond with Lynn and fell in love with the game of golf. He played in the PGA Jr. League when our team consisted of only 12 players and traveled to other courses for their events. Thanks to our donors, we now have 48 players, and The Legacy has its own league!

Since graduating from The Legacy's PGA Jr. League team, Tyler has gone on to excel at golf. He was the top player for Grand Rapids Community College for two years and competed in the National Junior College Golf Championship Tournament in 2022. He shot in the 70s in all four rounds of that tournament, leading his team to an eleventh-place finish. Tyler has also competed in two Michigan Opens, a United States Amateur Qualifying Tournament and plans to attempt to qualify for the Michigan Amateur this summer. Tyler is now 21 years old and still in love with the game of golf. He lives in Ionia and works in the golf shop at Egypt Valley Country Club, playing as much golf as possible. When asked about his time in the PGA Jr. League Tyler stated:

*"I wish I had more time to play PGA Jr. League. It was great for me, my golf game and taught me a lot of life lessons. It was the first time I was exposed to competitive golf, and I immediately fell in love with it. Some of my teammates from PGA Jr. League are still some of my best friends. People I compete against now are some of the same people I competed against in PGA Jr. It was a great experience overall and taught me maturity, independence, respect, and dedication. I learned all of that while having a great time learning about golf, and that is the way it should be, kids having fun."*

Tyler remains close with Coach Janson and plays in Lynn's Pro-Am each year.
